#### **TMS Assessment**

Client attended to assessment by himself, seen by ST/JP.

### **Presenting problem:**

Anxiety, depression

#### Socioeconomic Hx:

Sees Dr. Ty Drake for 12-18months

Previously seen George (child psychiatrist) unable to continue treatment due to

medications so changed to Dr Drake.

Noticed decreased appetite since

Worked cleaning trains for Sydney Train permanent night shift - ceased working 6 months

ago - that's when the depression hit

Partner , 2 daughters 6 and 2 years of age.

#### **MH Hx and PMHx:**

AuDHD

Daughter has Autism Dx

Childhood trauma didn't get picked up until a few years ago. (Alcohol, fighting)

Estranged from family for the last 6 months. Family = Full sister, 2 step sisters, step brother (stopped talking to family) No history of seizures Nil substance use or ETOH childhood ocd started washing hands heaps, having a shower before going into the room, checking cables of electronics.

Now wash feet in shower before going into room however recently has become laxed due to having children.

## Plan:

Right side RMT is 54% Treatment Dose is 59%

Start at 45% and increase quickly to 55% and then slowly increase up to 59% as sessions continue.
